RECOMMENDED ACTION

This application is being reviewed by the Recreation and Parks Commission for consideration and recommendation to the Colton City Council to develop a dog park on a 20,000 sq. foot area located at 1100 S. La Cadena Drive and name the park La Cadena Brook Dog Park.

BACKGROUND

The Incredible Edible Community Garden received recommendation to proceed with 145 tree planting at 1100 S. La Cadena Drive from the Recreation and Parks Commission members on March 15, 2017. The dog park would be an enhancement to the site location which has long been left unmaintained by the City.

ISSUES/ANALYSIS

The City has left the park located at 1100 S. La Cadena Drive unmaintained due to lack of water available to the site. With the improvements being done by the Incredible Edible Community Garden the site will have water available for improvements.

The dog park will consist of the following:

- Small and Large Dog park divided green chain link fencing
- Two pet fountains set on a concrete pad for water in entry of large and small dog park
- Recycled/Reuse of Fire hydrants strategically placed in Small and Large Dog Park areas
- Parking lot for up to 11 vehicles
- Two dog waste stations strategically placed in Small and Large Dog Park areas

FISCAL IMPACT

The park will require funds for the dog park fencing, two pet fountains and two dog waste stations, along with a budgeted traffic signal synchronization. Funds are available for the traffic signalization estimated at \$25,000-\$30,000 in account 249-1605-6150-6150-3890. Funds for the fencing and gravel parking lot is available in account 248-6200-6205-3890-0000-000 not to exceed \$25,000.
