

50+ CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

Welcome to Colton Community Services Department's Active Adult and Senior Programming at the Hutton Center. The Hutton Center is a daytime activity space where adults, ages 50 and above, can participate in recreation, socialization, educational and fitness activities, as well as find a variety of helpful and relevant services.

The City of Colton is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for our participants, visitors and staff. The Code was created to ensure a warm and supportive space for all who participate and work at the Centers. We hope these rules will allow Center participants to feel at ease, create an enjoyable atmosphere for all, and protect the facility we all enjoy using.

It is imperative that all participants act appropriately while at the Community Centers. This means that people should treat each other with dignity and respect at all times.

The following is considered unacceptable conduct:

- Profanity, vulgarity, or explicit sexual language
- Hate speech or epithets (e.g. racial, ethnic, sexist, homophobic or religious slurs)
- Harassment of any kind to anyone (other participants, visitors or staff)
- Fighting, physical abuse, challenging others to fight, destroying or damaging property
- Destruction of Center materials, equipment, furniture and grounds, or tampering with City equipment
- Promotion of or engaging in any illegal activities
- Participating in the use, possession, or sale of alcohol or Federally prohibited drugs
- Smoking, of any kind, inside or on City property
- Activities that infringe on the rights of Center participants or staff
- Inappropriate behavior or language that disturbs other participants
- Inconsiderate or discourteous behavior toward Center participants or staff
- Infractions against the Center's policies regarding loitering, sales or solicitation
- Vandalism or littering in the Center or on its grounds
- Violation of any federal, state, county or city laws and ordinances
- Inappropriate or revealing attire
- Failure to maintain personal cleanliness and good hygiene

We ask that you would:

- Be flexible in accepting alternate facility assignments or modifications to schedules due to maintenance, scheduling conflicts and emergency situations.
- As an eating establishment, follow all California Health Codes for physical hygiene.
- If you wish to circulate a petition or survey or promote/sell tickets for an organization or event that is not sponsored by the City, please seek the approval of the Center Coordinator before beginning such activities.

Each participant should be able to socialize and interact with others in an independent, positive manner. Everyone should treat those they encounter in the same manner that they would like to be treated.
